
Fish Study

John Kubisiak (DNR fisheries biologist - Oneida County) was contacted regarding plans for a fish study. He indeed plans to survey Horsehead beginning in spring. A crew will be out on the lake several times throughout the year running fyke nets and electro fishing. Stay tuned!

Weed Cutting

Schmidt's Landscaping has been contracted for 90 hours in 2010 for the 2nd week in July. Each season is different and produces variations of many natural phenomena. It

should be noted that if less plant/weed cutting is needed than we've budgeted, we could shorten the cutting time at no cost to the district.



Check Your Boats

Be sure your boat has NO plant material when you launch or land your boat in any WI lake. Police may give a \$500 ticket to those who do not comply anywhere in Oneida Co.

"No Wake Zone"

A recently passed law prohibits motorboats from making wakes closer than 100' from a shoreline. The purpose of this is two-fold: 1) help prevent the spread of invasive

<p>species in lakes, and 2) help prevent shoreline erosion that is a problem for many homeowners. Slow-no-wake is defined by the DNR as the minimum speed required to maintain steerage. Speed violations are the primary source of boating complaints in the summer. Speed is also a frequent cause of boat crashes, especially at night.</p>	<p>Goheen, of Aquatic Biologists, will repair the fan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Study by Oneida County Lakes & Rivers Association showed that Horsehead Lake is not conducive to hosting the invasive species zebra mussel. * Because of lake study, Horsehead Lake is eligible for a three-year weed-cutting permit.
