


WISCONSIN DNR FISHERIES INFORMATION SHEET

LAKE: Horsehead COUNTY: Oneida YEAR: 2019

The Department of Natural Resources surveyed Horsehead Lake, Oneida County, in June, to assess the fish community. The survey was conducted using boat electrofishing gear. Horsehead Lake is a spring fed lake with 367 surface acres, 5.0 miles of shoreline and a maximum depth of 11 feet.




Northern Pike

Northern Pike were the only gamefish documented during the survey. A total of 64 Northern Pike were handled. The average size of Northern Pike was 17.0 inches and the largest was 23.0 inches.

Yellow Perch

A total of 82 Yellow Perch were handled during the survey. The overall size structure of Yellow Perch was small with only 1 fish over 7 inches in length. The average size of Yellow Perch was 5.3 inches.



Other Species

In addition to the species listed above, we caught 11 Pumpkinseed (4-6 inches), 76 Golden Shiner and 4 Yellow Bullhead.
